TenderLink innovation - eValuation:

A new way for suppliers to respond to our RFTs is being considered by Regional Procurement. In addition to the standard electronic upload process currently in use, Regional Procurement is examining the benefits of those responses being analysed and ranked by eValuation. This innovative process allows Regional Procurement to upload evaluation criteria and weightings directly into the respective TenderLink tender notice. As suppliers upload their responses, the eValuation systems analyses each response against the predetermined criteria and provides Regional Procurement with a pre-populated matrix for further analysis.

Whilst it is early days yet, we can see the potential benefits in using the eValuation software package and will keep our valued client councils abreast of any further developments in this exciting area.
