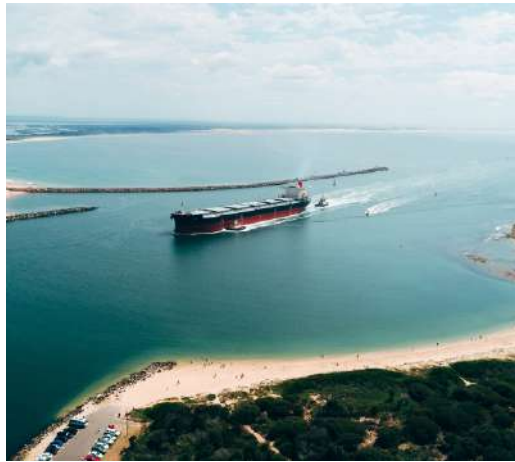




# *Regional Procurement*

Removal of newspaper advertising requirements under the Regulation.
