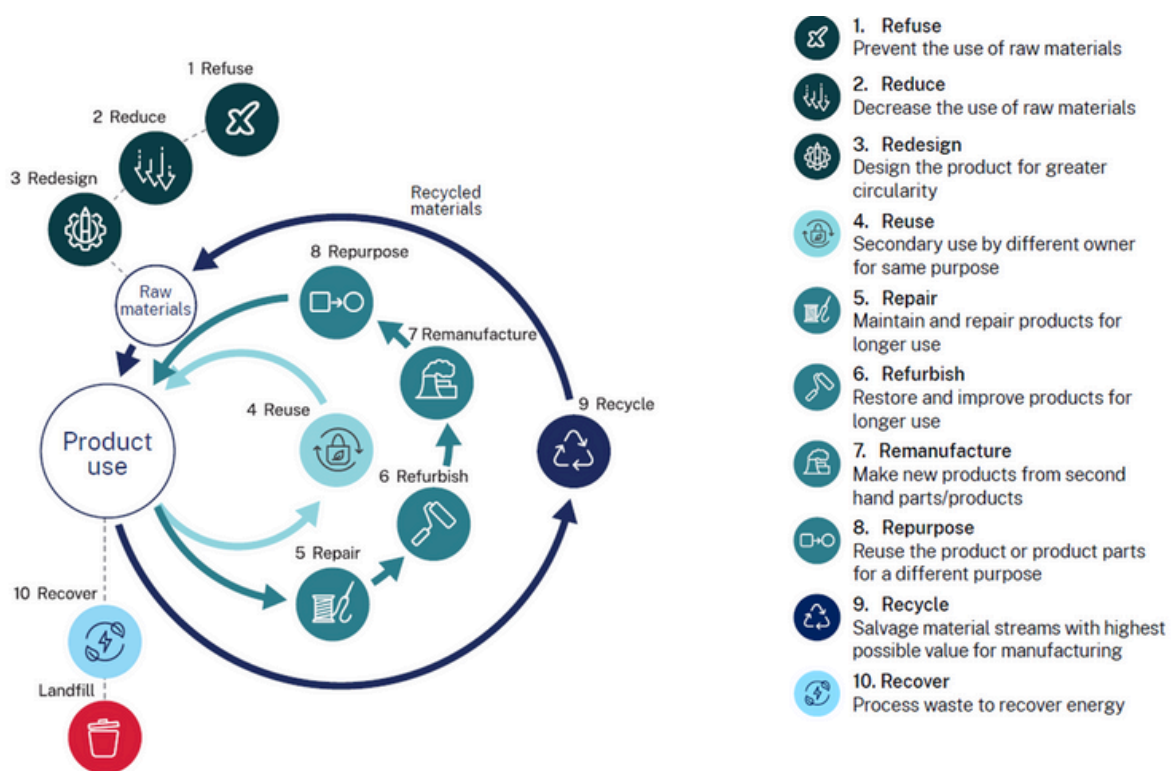

ADDRESSING MODERN SLAVERY RISKS
